Botanics have played a pivotal role in the history of Wynyard and as custodians of this estate,
we continue to build that legacy.

Explore our iconic gardens and arboretum set within the 120 acre private grounds.
The Gardens at Wynyard Hall date back to 1623 and have endured many different stages in
their development and restoration since.

The most notable phase in the history of the gardens would be during the ownership of the 6th
Marquess and in particular his wife, Lady Theresa Londonderry who were thought to bring the estate
back to life after a period of decay and neglect. Theresa brought creative energy and vision to
the development of the formal gardens. A garden album created by Lady Theresa in 1912, records in
affectionate detail the gardens she created and adored “It was she who made Wynyard” Wynyard
Tenants, 1844.

Filled with the finest locally sourced food and drink from the North-East, along with our
estate grown produce, the Farmshop is a celebration of artisanal suppliers and products. Perfect
for lunch, the café offers a light, airy space to suppliers and products. Perfect for a catch up

Visual Impairment - General Information

We have contrast markings on all glass doors, contrast markings on all full-height windows and high colour contrast between walls and doorframes.

Ticket/Information Desk

From the main entrance to the desk, there is level access.

The area is well and evenly lit by ceiling spot lights

From the main entrance to this area, there is level access.

Public Toilet

Unisex Accessible Toilet

There is a public toilet for visitors.

From the main entrance to the public toilet, there is level access.

There are horizontal grab rails located to the left of the toilet. There are baby changing facilities within this toilet. There is another public toilet on the same floor.

The gardens are graveled in a honeycomb gravel stabilisation grid system. There are some steps on in the gardens however alternative access is available to easily maneuver around these.

The Shop

From the main entrance to the shop, there is level access.

The route through the shop is 800mm wide, or more.

The flooring within the shop is tile. There is one main entrance to the Farm Shop.

There is low level background music playing.

The Café

To get to a table, there are no steps.

The route through the Farmshop to the café is 800mm wide, or more.

There is low volume background music.

The tables and plates have high colour contrast.

We cater for sugar free (diabetic), vegetarian and gluten free (celiacs) specific diets.

We also provide soya milk for coffee, tea and hot chocolate.
